Families are strongly encouraged to go to lunchapp.com for quick results or complete a paper application as soon as possible to continue receiving benefits.

### **Lunchroom Expectations**

The Plumbrook school lunch room and recess are supervised by adults.

- Eat quietly and use good table manner
- Remain seated until dismissed by an adult supervisor
- Place all trash and recyclable items in proper containers

- Leave the table in a clean condition for other children
- Show respect for others

#### Absences

To report your child's absence, please call our absence line at 586-797-6099 and leave a message. Please clearly state your child's name, teacher, date, reason for the absence, and if your child will be ordering hot lunch for the next day. The answering machine will take absence calls between 3:30 p.m. and 8:30 a.m. You may use the office line during regular school hours.

## The Elementary School Parent and Student Handbook

### **PowerSchool Parent Portal**

If you do not have access to PowerSchool Parent Portal, please stop into the school office to pick up the login information. Parent Portal is the key to receiving student academic updates: progress reports and report cards.

#### Communication

UCS supports electronic communication as a very effective way to communicate with our families through email news updates, electronic phone calls, and text messages. Please be certain that your email address is up to date and your phone numbers are current, so that you can receive valuable and timely school information.

## Plumbrook Parking Lot Procedures

Just a reminder to **park only in designated parking spaces**. Be remember not to park, stand, or wait for students in the bus lane or the yellow stripped parking spaces. The orange cones in the yellow stripped bus lane designate the beginning of the drop-off/pick-up lane for easy student drop off/pick up before/after school.

At the end of the school day, we ask that parents park their vehicles in the school lot and walk up to their child's exit door to safely walk their child to their vehicle. If you leave your car for any reason, please remember to turn off the car and take your keys. **Please drive with extreme caution** as students and parents are crossing the parking lot.

Should your child need to be dismissed early, please let their teacher know in advance if possible. It will be necessary for you to report to the school office and sign your child out. At that time, your child will be called down to the office for dismissal. Should your child return to school the same day it will be necessary to come into the office and sign them back in.

## **Visitors**

In accordance with school district policy, everyone entering Plumbrook must report directly to the main office through entrance #1. Our office staff will be happy to help you. If you are volunteering, or have a prearranged visit planned with your child's teacher, you will need to sign in. All visitors will be given a visitor sticker to wear. For student safety purposes, your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated

#### Volunteers

Keep this in mind as we move through the class party season: Halloween and Christmas. To protect students' health, safety and welfare, every volunteer must have a Volunteer Request form on

file well in advance of volunteering their assistance at school or school related events. UCS conducts criminal background checks on volunteers through the Michigan State Police. The form, which asks for basic information such as a driver's license number, is available through the school office.

## Meeting with Teachers

Our teachers at Plumbrook are always happy to meet with you! Please make an appointment with your child's teacher before or after school to avoid any interruptions to the students' instructional time.

#### Administration of Medicine

Parents should administer medication to their children at home. If this is not possible, the school may administer their prescription or non-prescription medicine **only** when authorized by the student's parent/guardian. Requests must be made by completing an Authorization for Medication form available in the office and signed by a physician.

As a part of the Utica Community Schools, we hold high expectations regarding the success and achievement of all our students. Our staff strives to provide the most positive learning environment possible for academic, social, and behavioral growth. We value a strong partnership between home and school based on two-way communication, cooperation, and trust.
